



The eagle is holding **Arrows for war and an Olive branch for peace.**

- Arrows refer to the war the tribes of Israel are to fight. They are to return from captivity to fight a war. Shown as the arrows, they are called Daughter of troops.

**5 Now gather thyself in troops, O daughter of troops:** he hath laid siege against us: they shall smite the judge of Israel with a rod upon the cheek.

- The olive branch is a symbol of peace. And Micah states this man shall be our peace speaking of the man from Bethlehem of old. Matthew at the time of the birth of Jesus related this to him

<sup>2</sup>But thou, Bethlehem Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that is to be ruler in Israel; whose goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting.

<sup>3</sup>Therefore will he give them up, until the time that she which travaileth hath brought forth: then the remnant of his brethren shall return unto the children of Israel.

<sup>4</sup>And he shall stand and feed in the strength of the Lord, in the majesty of the name of the Lord his God; and they shall abide: for now shall he be great unto the ends of the earth.

<sup>5</sup>**And this man shall be the peace**, when the Assyrian shall come into our land: and when he shall tread in our palaces, then shall we raise against him seven shepherds, and eight principal men.

- Seven Shepherds are the seven priests that will fight in this war according to the 1QM. War Scroll. They are part of the Eight principal men. The eight is Jesus.

<sup>6</sup>And they shall waste the land of Assyria with the sword, and the land of Nimrod in the entrances thereof: thus shall he deliver us from the Assyrian, when he cometh into our land, and when he treadeth within our borders.

- This is Isis . They destroyed the Nimrods Palace entrances in 2015 and wasted the land of ancient Assyria.

<sup>7</sup>And the remnant of Jacob shall be in the midst of many people as a dew from the Lord, as the showers upon the grass, that tarrieth not for man, nor waiteth for the sons of men.

<sup>8</sup>And the remnant of Jacob shall be among the Gentiles in the midst of many people as a lion among the beasts of the forest, as a young lion among the flocks of sheep: who, if he go through, both treadeth down, and teareth in pieces, and none can deliver.

- The tribes will first speak up for Israel like a lion as they are in the forests of nations
- When they will return to Israel, they will be part of God's sheep

<sup>9</sup>Thine hand shall be lifted up upon thine adversaries, and all thine enemies shall be cut off.

<sup>10</sup>And it shall come to pass in that day, saith the Lord, that I will cut off thy horses out of the midst of thee, and I will destroy thy chariots:

<sup>11</sup>And I will cut off the cities of thy land, and throw down all thy strong holds:

<sup>12</sup>And I will cut off witchcrafts out of thine hand; and thou shalt have no more soothsayers:

- The tribes will fight and Jesus will fight for them and win.

<sup>13</sup>Thy graven images also will I cut off, and thy standing images out of the midst of thee; and thou shalt no more worship the work of thine hands.

<sup>14</sup>And I will pluck up thy groves out of the midst of thee: so will I destroy thy cities.

<sup>15</sup>And I will execute vengeance in anger and fury upon the heathen, such as they have not heard.
